want to confirm our conversation of today regarding the Joseph Stein Jr. Compassion Award Fund which you established in 2004 through your very generous gift of \$10,000 made through the Jewish Communal Fund. We had initially established this fund as an endowment; however, in November of 2004 you indicated that your preference was to grant an award to be \$1,000 to each year's recipient and that we should use both the interest and the principal. As such, in 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007 each award was in the amount of \$1,000.

Currently the fund balance is \$7,964. Interest earned in 08 was \$593. As we agreed today, as of this year and going forward, each recipient will receive a \$500. Award and we will use the interest, and if needed, the principal.
